**CLASS:** Community Living Assistance and Support Services

**MDCP:** Medically Dependent Children’s Program

## Medicaid Waiver

- Offers services that are typically not covered under basic Medicaid coverage. Services include respite care, attendant care, home modifications, residential options, adaptive aids, camp, specialized therapies and habilitation.
- Allows states to waive certain Medicaid eligibility requirements for the delivery of unique services to a specific population.
- Allows for community based services for individual who would otherwise be in an institution
- Do not consider parental income or resources.
- Have long interest lists that are over 10 years so sign up early!
- A person does not have to be Medicaid eligible to be placed on the interest level.
- A person can be on more than one interest level at the same time.
- Contact the Medicaid Waiver number annually to verify status. Notify the program of any changes of address or phone number.
- Medicaid Waivers are not moved from state to state.
